



## Creating an Account and using the MOOCs

To use the MOOCs and to download the certificates, users need to register an account on the T3W website.


(1) Go to <https://thethirdway.eu/> and click on **'My Account'** at the top right:




(2) Click on the turquoise **'Login'-Button**:




- (3) A small window will open up where you can click '**Register an Account**' on the right hand side:




- (4) You can then enter a **username** and an **e-mail address** which the confirmation e-mail will be sent to. You will need to enter a **captcha** to prove you're not a robot:




- (5) You will then have to **confirm your registration** by clicking the link in the e-mail you have received from WordPress. You can then **set a password** and use it together with your username or E-Mail address to login (on the left hand side of the window shown above).
- (6) Once logged in, you can start your learning by **clicking on each module/course** and **clicking on the first (or any) lesson**:



- (7) When you're done reading/studying, just click on the **turquoise button** on the bottom right to get to the **next lesson** or the **next topic**:




- (8) You can always see the **progress** you've made in a module on the **first page** of the course. Once you've completed it and earned a **certificate**, you can **download** it there as often as you need to:
